

## *Kauni knitting instructions no. 9*

### **Model no. 1: PONCHO WITH ROSES**

**Materials:** Kauni efektyarn 8/2

**Size.** One Size

**Yarn needed:** 510g

**Colour recommendations:** Effect yarn EV and all effect yarns from Kauni

**Needles:** Size 2.5 mm

**Knitting tension:** 20 sts and 35 rows in stocking sts=10x10 cm. If you are knitting too tight change to a larger size needle. If you are knitting too loose change to smaller needle size.

**Pattern no. 1A.** Cast on 65 sts (= approx 30 cm in width) on needle size 2.5 mm. Work the beginning of all rows from the RS as follows: *K1, P1, K1, P1*. This makes a band of approx. 1.5 cm see drawing 1. Work remaining stitched in stocking sts and Rose pattern (2.5 roses) according to diagram, for 1 repeat and continue with base colour until the *square measures approx. 30 x 30 cm*. Cast off all sts. Notice when the base colour is dark, then choose a lighter colour for the pattern. Make another square in pattern 1A.

**Pattern no. 1B.** Cast on 65 sts (= approx 30 cm in width) on needle size 2.5 mm. Work the end of all rows from the RS as follows: *K1,P1, K1,P1*. This makes a band of approx. 1.5 cm see drawing 1. Work remaining stitched in stocking sts and Rose pattern (2.5 roses) according to diagram, for 1 repeat and continue with base colour until the square measures approx. 30 x 30 cm. Cast off all sts. Make another square in pattern 1B.

**Pattern no. 2A.** Cast on 65 sts (= approx 30 cm in width) on needle size 2.5 mm. Work in stocking sts and Rose pattern according to diagram throughout = 2.5 x 3 roses. Noticing that the rose patterns are staggered 1/2 rose compared to the pattern below - this is also shown in the diagram. After 3 repeats the square measures approx. 30 x 30 cm. Cast off all sts. Make another square in pattern 2A.

**Pattern no. 2B.** Cast on 65 sts (= approx 30 cm in width) on needle size 2.5 mm. Work 4 rows in garter sts see drawing 1. Continue in stocking sts and rose pattern (2.5 x 3 roses), but work the beginning of all rows from the RS as follows: *K1, P1, K1, P1*. This makes a band of approx. 1.5 cm. noticing that the rose patterns are staggered 1/2 rose compared to the pattern row below - this is also shown in the diagram. After 3 repeats the square measures approx. 30 x 30 cm. Cast off all sts. Make another square in pattern 2B.

**Left arm sleeve.** Cast on 115 sts (= approx 60 cm in width) on needle size 2.5 mm. Inc. 1 st at the beginning of each row from the RS. Continue in stocking sts until the piece measures 15 cm. The sleeve now measures 20

cm. Then continue in stocking sts without any inc. or dec. see drawing 1 until the piece measures 56 cm. Work 100 sts from the RS, cast off 5 sts for the neck opening see drawing 2. and continue to cast off for the right side of the neck opening as follows: Cast off from the WS at the beginning of every other row: *2,1,1,1* sts a total of 5 sts see *drawing 2*=89 sts in left. Work 4 rows in stocking sts and then inc. at the end of the for *each row from the RS for 2,2,2,2,1,1,1, 1,1,1,1,1,1,1 sts.=60 cm in the width*. Then work the left part of the neck opening according to drawing 2. Cast off from the RS at the beginning of every other row: *2,2,1,1,1,1,1,1* sts. Join the sleeve, see drawing 1. Pick up 58 sts at the *sleeve opening and work in Rib (K1,P1)* for approx. 8 cm. Cast off all sts. The length of the sleeve can also be adjusted at this point.

**Right arm Sleeve.** Work as left arm sleeve, but reverse.

**Collar.** Pick up 102 sts around the neck line and work approx. 20 cm in rib (*K1, P1*). Cast off all sts.

### **Model no. 2: LARGE SCARF IN TULIP PATTERN**

**Materials:** Kauni effekt – lace yarn 8/1

**Size:** One size.

**Yarn needed:** 140g

**Colour recommendations:** XEQ or all other Kauni effekt-laceyarns

**Needles:** Circular needles size 5mm (to work back and forth on) **Knitting tension:** 17 sts and 16 rows in stocking sts = 10x10 cm. If you are knitting too tight change to a larger size needle. If you are knitting too loose change to smaller needle size.

**Finish measures:** 100 x 180 cm

**Beginning edge:** Cast on 151 sts with circular needle size 5 mm and work 2 rows of garter sts. Continue to work according to edge-diagram 1. The diagram is seen from the RS and are read from right to left as you will see the sts in the final scarf. The width of the scarf = 19 tongues. Work 22 rows according to edge-diagram 1. Inc. 2 sts on row 23rd = 153 sts in total. Work the last row - row 24 - according to edge-diagram 1.

**Pattern:** Work according to pattern-diagram with 6 sts pattern sts each side according to pattern-diagram and a repeat of the 10 pattern sts in between (= 14 pattern repeats). After the last repeat *K1* sts and finish with the 6 patterns sts for the edge (see diagram). Purl all sts from the WS. The length of the scarf =10.5 pattern repeats. The last 1/2 pattern repeat are shown with a grey background and includes row 1 to 7. *K* the last row - row 8.

**Finishing edge:** Work the finishing edge according to edge-diagram 2. on the 2nd row dec. 2 sts = 151 sts in total. Work the last row in diagram with double thread to strengthen the edge as follows: *K2* sts tog. *K1* st from previous sts, *K2* sts tog. *K1* st from previous sts and so on.

**Finishing:** Wash the shawl with wool shampoo or wool

soap. Block the shawl with pins to the given size and leave it to dry.

### **Model no. 3: CARDIGAN FOR CHILDREN IN LACE PATTERN.**

**Materials:** Kauni single colour 100% wool 8/2 and Kauni effekt yarn 8/2.

**Size:** 92 - 2 years(104 - 4 years)116 - 6 years

**Burst:** 31(33)36 cm

**Length:** 34(38)42 cm

**Sleeve length:** 27(36)41 cm

**Yarn needed:** 140(150)160 g

**Colour recommendations:**Base colour EE,edge RR7, pattern JJ7.

**Needles:**Circular needles size 3mm to work back and forth on)

**Knitting tension:** 22 sts and 25 rows = 10x10 cm. If you are knitting too tight change to a larger size needle. If you are knitting too loose change to smaller needle size.

**Body:** The body is done in one piece (front and back at the same time). Cast on with green wool 136(144)160 sts and work according to diagram no. 1. Slip the 1st. st on all rows (edge st). Work 2 rows in green and continue with 2 rows of rose. Change to base colour and continue until piece measures 21(24)27 cm

**Front piece right side:** Cast off for the armholes as follows: Work 34(36)40 sts from the RS turn the piece cast off 8(8)10 and purl the WS back. Then work 5 rows in stocking sts and continue with the rose pattern according to diagram no. 2. When the armhole measures 11 cm, cast off 15 sts from the RS for the neck opening = 15 sts left. Continue with the rose pattern according to diagram no. 2. When the rose pattern is completed continue in base colour until the armhole measures 15 cm and cast off all sts for the shoulder.

**Front piece left side:** As right side but mirror image.

**Back piece:** Continue the back piece on the remaining sts and cast off beg. of the following 2 rows 8(8)10 sts for the armholes = 52(56)60 sts remaining. Work 5 rows in stocking sts and continue with the rose pattern according to diagram no. 2. When the rose pattern is completed work 2 rows in stocking sts using the base colour.

**Back piece right side:** Work from the RS. K to the middle of row, turn and cast off 12,2,1 sts at the beg. of every other (from WS)for the neck opening =15 sts left. When the armhole measure 15 cm cast off remaining sts for the shoulder.

**Back piece left side:** Work from the RS. Cast off 12, 2, 1 sts at the beg. of every other row (from RS). When armhole measures 15 cm cast off remaining sts for the shoulder.

**Sleeves:** Cast on with green wool 36(38)42 sts and work according to diagram no. 1. Slip the 1st on all rows (edge

st). Work 2 rows in green and continue with 2 rows of rose. Change to base colour and continue according to diagram no. 1. When piece measures 3(5)4 cm inc.1 sts each side on every 4(5)6row until you have a total of 60(64)68sts. Continue straight up until the sleeve measures 27(36)41cm.Cast off all sts.

**Collar:** Join the shoulders and pick up sts with needle size 3 mm along the neck line for the collar. Work 5 rows in stocking sts alternating between rose and green colours, 1 row of each. Finish with 3 rows of rose and cast off all sts.

**Zip back piece:** Cast on 4 sts on needle size 3 mm and work in stocking sts until it fits the length of the front band. Join the sleeves to the body. Set in the zipper, sew the edge/zip back piece onto the WS.

### **Model no. 4: CARDIGAN FOR CHILDREN.**

**Materials:** Kauni single colour 100% wool 8/2.

**Size:** 92 - 2 years(98 - 3 years)110 - 5 years

**Burst:** 30(32)35 cm

**Length:** 32(36)38 cm

**Sleeve length:** 24(33)38 cm

**Yarn needed:** 165(180)200 g

**Colour recommendations:** Base colour JJ8, edge JJ7, patternAA

**Needles:** Size 2 and 3 mm

**Knitting tension:** On needle size 3 mm: 25 sts and 36 rows in stocking sts = 10x10 cm. If you are knitting too tight change to a larger size needle. If you are knitting too loose change to smaller needle size.

**Back piece:** Cast on 75(80)88 with edge colour on needle size 2 mm. Work 12 rows in stocking sts. Then beg. from the RS change to needle size 3 mm and continue according to diagram. After the pattern is completed continue with Rib K3, P3 and base colour for another 18(24)27 cm. Cast off for the armhole each side on every other row for: 3,2,2,2 (3,2,2,2) 3,3,2,2 sts = 9(9)10 sts in total = 57(62)68 sts left. Continue for another 12(14)15 cm straight up. Then cast off for the neckline from the RS as follows: Work 15(15)18 sts, cast off the middle 19(24)24 sts for the neckline=15(15)18sts remaining. Now cast off both sides for the neckline on every other row for 2 x 2 sts = 4 sts in total = 11(11)14 sts left. Cast off remaining sts for the shoulder. Make sure each side is a mirror image of each other.

**Front piece left side:** Work the front edge border with 6 stocking sts throughout. Cast on 38(40)44 sts with edge colour on needle size 2 mm. Work 12 rows in stocking sts. Then beg. from the RS change to needle size 3 mm and continue according to diagram. After the pattern is completed continue with Rib K3, P3 in base colour for another 18(24)27 cm. Cast off for the armhole at the side on every other row for: 3,2,2,2 (3,2,2,2) 3,3,2,2 sts = 9(9)10 sts in total = 29(31)34 sts left. Continue for another
